Registrar's Report 4th May 2022

Since May 2021, we have gained information on several cars that were previously unknown to the Register. We now hold information on a total of 1243 "live" cars worldwide, an increase of 6.

The total number of cars on record amount to 1,973 and we can confirm that of this number, 177 are regarded as being dead. The remaining 553 cars are hopefully resting, awaiting discovery and are currently unclassified. Who knows? There have been 30 cars that have changed ownership.

The accuracy of the information we hold is not always consistent with the current status of individual vehicles. It is possible that, over the period since the Register was formed, some of the cars listed as "live" may no longer be so.

On our database, cars are given a "live" designation where information has been received since 1991 when the Register gained its independence from the T Register. "Live" does not necessarily mean that the car is roadworthy. It may be awaiting or undergoing restoration.
